This does NOT include:

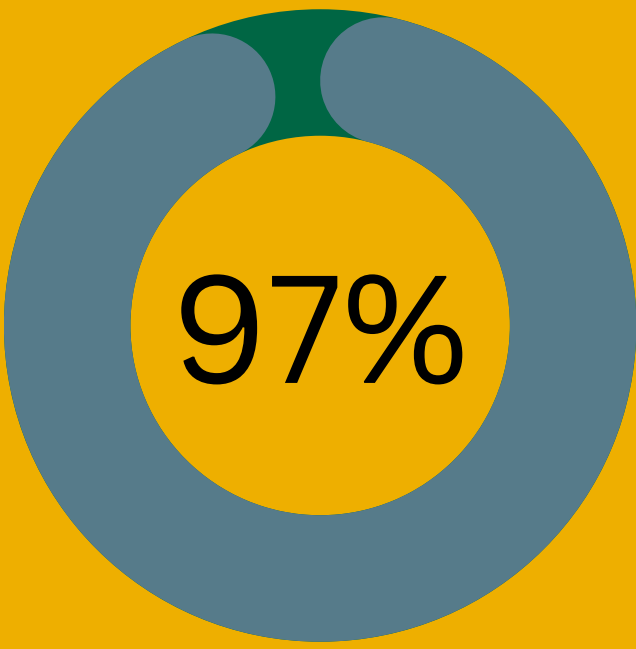
- Reports that come directly from Public Safety

This includes cases heard by the Community Standards staff, Residence Life teams, Dean of Students, and the Assoc. Dean of Students - Thank you!



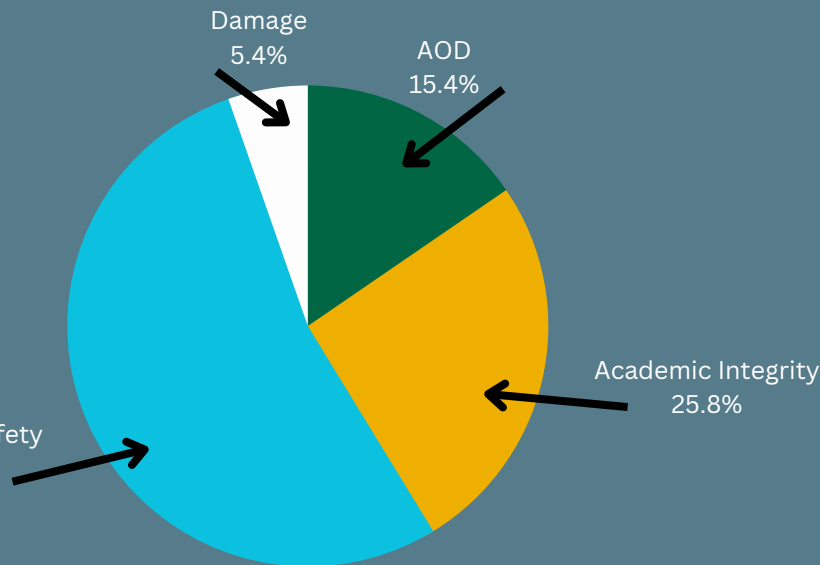
### Types of Cases
