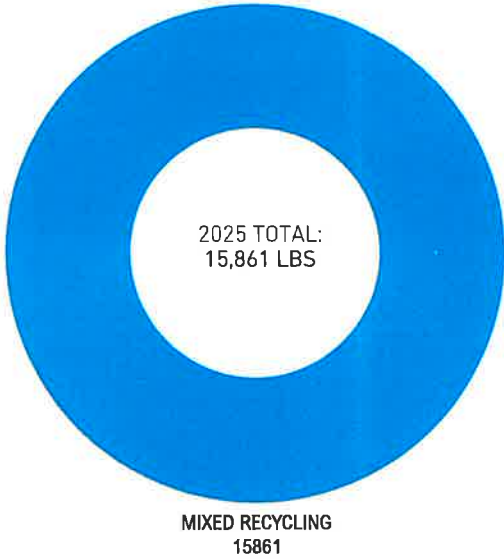

ANNUAL WEIGHT TOTALS & RECYCLING BREAKDOWNS (PER LBS)

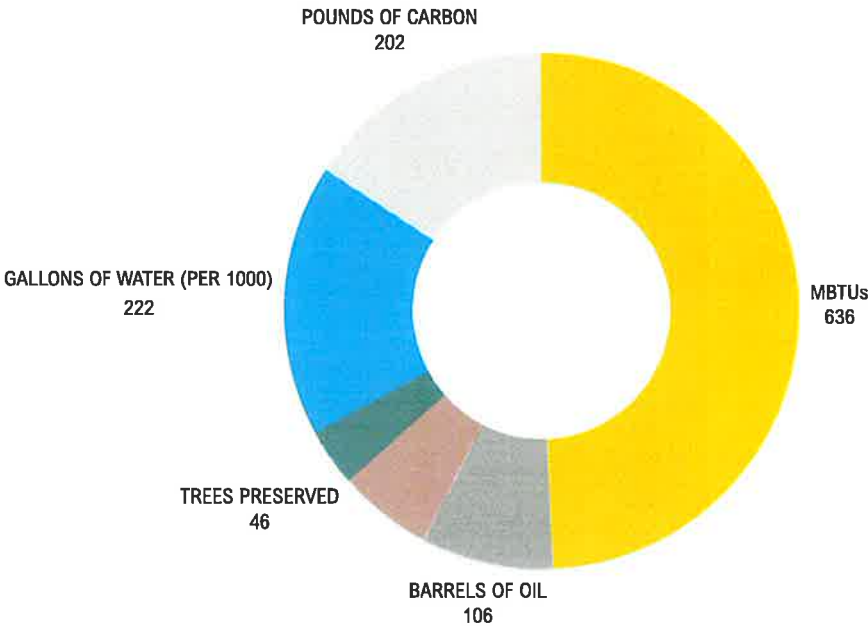

RE-STREAM'S DONATION PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Re-Stream maintains strong donation partnerships with schools and charitable organizations through multiple distribution channels. Items reserved for donation by Re-Stream's clients are primarily distributed during our free Teacher Supply Events, where school staff are invited to browse available inventory at our warehouse. These events are scheduled based on both inventory levels and warehouse availability, and school employees are contacted in advance to coordinate participation.

In preparation for these events, Re-Stream warehouse staff organize donated items and store them in a designated area specifically reserved for future donations. When a formal event date has not yet been established, teachers are encouraged to schedule individual appointments to visit the warehouse and collect items they have inquired about. These items may include office furniture, supplies, household appliances, and other miscellaneous goods deemed suitable for donation.

When inventory levels permit, Re-Stream may offer weekly open browsing hours, allowing individuals to visit the warehouse at their convenience, which is particularly beneficial for those with scheduling or accessibility constraints.

For large-scale donations, Re-Stream also facilitates truck deliveries directly to public schools or charities in need. These efforts not only prevent usable items from ending up in landfills but also help our clients extend their positive impact into local communities.
